General agreements:

We revised our application form and got to the following agreements:

- To make a chart as stated above with PRODUCTS, ACTIVITIES, UPDATING AND PLACE
- This chart specifies the agreements with the general description of activities and products, as well as Where and When.
- To name the products to get as: **Notice Board, Webpage, Blog, Wiki, Web Conference, Multimedia Phrase Book, Democratic Values Leaflet, Reading Plan, Traditional Story/play, Food and Nutrition Book, Sports Competition, Joint Song, Evaluations**
- Each of these products will be in the Menu of the Webpage, and this will be used only to place General Information and the products themselves. Each partner has their username and password to edit it
- The coordinator country will send clear instructions for the Webpage, blog, wiki and videoconference handling.
- The Blog will be used as a News Tool, to give regular information of our activities, mainly through the students' Panels
- The Wiki will be used for a group work, teamwork, sharing information and creation of a joint product
- The Web Conference should be used 4 times during the project, or more if requested, and students should be also in the panel
- Pupils will upload information on the blog, as planned, and topics should be discussed during the project meetings
- The e-mail will be our regular communication tool, once every week, and we should send our e-mails to the whole group, so everyone is informed at the same time.
- The timing of the different activities specified in the chart.
- The FOCUS for each mobility meeting. There may be more than one focus at a specific meeting,
- The ICT to use: webpage, blog, wiki, e-mail, video conference, Skype, Facebook, etc. This is to be confirmed, as security is paramount.
- The mobility dates :

- The student mobilities will depend on each country management of budget, but we have to agree before each mobility to bring the pupils who will participate.
- We have to share the protocols, forms or charts that we use for each activity
- The webpage, blog, wiki, will include pictures, videos, etc, and these will be uploded as .jpeg or .jpg files.
- Each country needs a coordinator for the webpage, blog, wiki and videoconference.
- Everything should be in English and in each country's language
- Every country will send us information about travel arrangements, flights possibilities, and accommodation options in order to prepare the visit in advance. The first visit to come is Poland.
- Try to book the flight and accommodation for the mobilities as soon as possible, so that they might be cheaper.
- Students should live in students' families. This has to be arragened fairly in advance.
- It should be desirable that communication between pupils has existed before the visit.
- It would be good to share students' emails who are likely to participate in the mobilities.
- Pupils will participate in gathering information, planning and preparing products, communicating with pupils from partner institutions
- Pupils will present their findings to all members of the partnership.
- Pupils will be responsible for editing the content of the panels, and upload it on the blog page
- Pupils will be encouraged to evaluate the activities, provide feedback.
- Pupils will lead assemblies in their own institutions to communicate their activities and learning to all pupils and staff.
- Pupils will be given opportunities to train their peers on the customs, traditions and positive standards of behavior, culture in public places, use polite language form in everyday communication in a play they will have to perform in the project.
- In order to actively involve staff and for them to learn from the partnership they will be given opportunities to work shadow a colleague during mobility visits.
- They will work alongside a teacher in the host school for part of a day to engage with pupils and gather information about different approaches to teaching and learning.
- Photos or videos are to be recorded on the activities done but above all when the meetings take place, and upload them in the appropriate place of the Webpage. There should be a person responsible for taking the photos and for selecting and uploading them.
